Renacer de las Palmas (Rebirth of Las Palmas)

3. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Why?

Briefly describe the needs or problems this project is trying to address:

The 45 houses in Las Palmas do not have toilets with running water. The water is brought in buckets, after hours of walking on rugged terrain and is not drinkable. In the rainy season a small amount of rainwater is collected. There are no toilets, no showers, no sinks, no laundry facilities or dishwashers.

Women and children are responsible for transporting the water they need on their shoulders.

The monoculture of panela sugar cane has caused deforestation, the erosion of agricultural land, and the deterioration of fauna and flora.

The lack of opportunities has caused an exodus to the capital of the country and the abandonment of farms.

Impact:

Who will benefit from this project?

There are 180 inhabitants in the rural villages of Canta Gallo and Las Vueltas located in the Municipality of Las Palmas, Cundinamarca, Colombia. The villages are mostly inhabited by the elderly, women and children. Young people and adults have migrated to the city and return temporarily. The Peace Process is driving this return to their lands.

Aims:

What do you want this project to achieve?

- Ensure survival through improvements in health and hygiene conditions.
 - Ensure a basic food supply.
 - Open up job opportunities in the area.

Results:

What specific results and outcomes do you expect to see?

Decrease the infant mortality rate to less than 1% in 3 years.

Decrease by 20% morbidity, defined as the amount of people who are sick in a given place and time.

Increase by 50% the per capita income of the inhabitants of the villages, through forming and activating an entity (cooperative or agricultural associative company), that promotes the agro-industrial development of the area.

Increase the area of native forest, in the hamlets, by 10% in five years.
